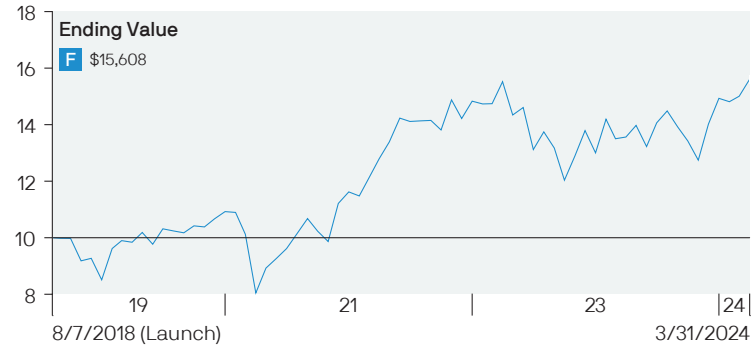

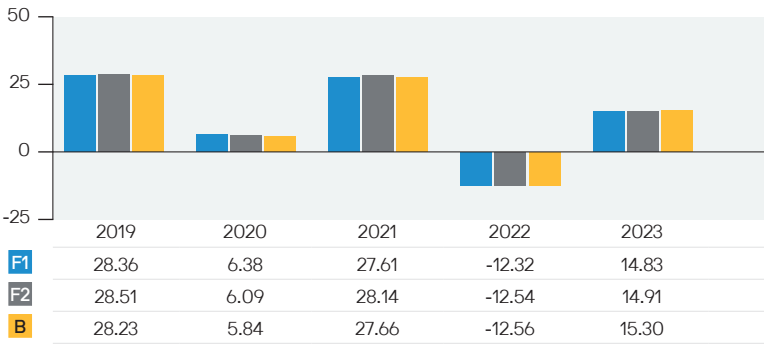

Definitions
